From 09h00am the masses will march from Pretoria City Hall to the Kara Heritage Village where the interfaith ceremony will take place.

Objectives of the interfaith prayers

- To pray for peace and reconciliation following the killings of our fellow African brothers and sisters.
- To highlight the right of all Africans, to work and trade anywhere in Africa subject to the laws of the host countries.
- To remind ourselves that slavery, colonialism, and apartheid, not our African brothers and sisters, are the causes of the triple challenges of poverty, unemployment and inequality.
- To raise awareness of our common African humanity, identity and unity in diversity.
- To promote, internalise, deepen, and entrench the spirit of patriotism and internationalism in our youth and children.
- To remind ourselves that only all Africans and African countries working together can overcome the triple challenge of poverty, unemployment and inequalities which fuel racism, xenophobia, Afrophobia, and other forms of intolerances.
